### YOUR LOCAL FIRE CREWS NEED YOUR HELP!

### YOU CAN HELP STOP MOST OF THESE FIRES! Just follow these simple steps...

- Don't block escape routes with rubbish or rubbish containers.
- Keep rubbish or rubbish containers away from windows, doors or other openings to buildings which could spread fire.
- · Wheelie bins should be immobilised away from the building.
- Keep rubbish or rubbish containers away from possible ignition sources e.g. electrical heaters, boiler flue pipes.
- Prohibit smoking in or around storage and refuse areas.
- Keep lids on bins whenever possible.
- Do not place refuse against the outside of the building.
- Keep bins and bags in locked containers or secure areas.
- Do not allow waste to gather contact your council or contractor to arrange an uplift.
- Put refuse out for uplift as close as possible to the collection time.
- Ensure you have a Fire Action Plan in case of a fire within your building/bin room.
- Prohibiting or restricting access to storage & refuse areas to members of the public will cut down the likelihood of fires being set.
- Make sure that hot items,
  e.g. hot embers, are not put in the bin.
